First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the ninth day of July
A. D. 1925, at Ogden City County of Weber
and State of Utah, in The Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George C. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An indeterminate term of from
one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank C. Doran
I was convicted under the name of Frank C. Doran
