Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th, day of November,

and State of Utah, in Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Bradrick Woody presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One year to Five years,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joseph Zizic.
I was convicted under the name of Joseph Zizic.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Present one.
