First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison,
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary,

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 31st day of July,
A. D. 1924 at Ogden Utah, County of Weber
and State of Utah, in 2nd District, Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. M. Hinckley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 1 to 20 years in the
Utah State Prison,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable District Atty. General prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Jesse Byrd
I was convicted under the name of Jesse Byrd.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except minor ones.
