I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination,
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison,
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary.

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th, day of January

from one to Twenty years
