Your request for information dated Sep.10-1923,
In-re the above named matter, received and noted. The de-
fendant appeared in Court on July 7- charged with issuing
a check of \$21.00 without sufficient funds in the bank
to pay the same, to which charge he pleaded guilty. On May
14- he had entered his plea of guilty to a similar charge
and paid a fine of \$30.00. It appeared that he was very
much in the habit of doing that kind of business and as I
remember his people were paying the bills. A much more
serious charge than the one filed against him on July 7th
might I think have been filed. Under the circumstances a
penalty of 90 days in jail was imposed which I think was
not excessive in this case.
