Application of John Stine

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of July A. D. 1923, at Park City Utah, County of Summit and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Fuerson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term in The Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. C. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Stine I was convicted under the name of John Stine

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: John Neel who was terminated on the June Board June 1924

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
