Application of John Stine

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of July
A. D. 1923, at Coalville County of Summit
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable H. A. Iverson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Stine
I was convicted under the name of John Stine

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: John Neal -- He was released
from here on March 21st 1924.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except--
