and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge G. S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate term
One to ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable J. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John William Harley
I was convicted under the name of Jack Harley

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
