First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 17 day of Oct  
A. D. 1923, at Ogden Utah County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Barker presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to one to ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth -- Honorable J. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is John W. Hurley  
I was convicted under the name of Jack Hurley

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
