Application of Arthur Meier

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 29 day of Jan. A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence, not less than one and not more than ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison Salt Lake City Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable W. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Arthur Henry Meier I was convicted under the name of Arthur Henry Meier

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Oscar Page.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
