Application of Arthur Meier

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of Jan. 1924  
A. D., at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Sentence  
in the Utah State Prison  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison  
Salt Lake City Utah

Fourth -- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Arthur Henry Meier  
I was convicted under the name of Arthur Henry Meier
