County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chas. J. Burton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate
sentence of 1 year to twenty
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
at Salt Lake City Utah

Fourth-- Honorable N. B. Higgins prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of James Mc Carthy
