Application of Earl Hawkins

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parol or termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Box Elder County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of unlawfully transporting intoxicating liquor.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of July A. D. 1925, at Brigham City County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in City Court of Brigham City Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Fred J. Holton, City Judge presiding.
