Mrs. Myrtle Simon, being first duly sworn says that she resides at Lehi, Utah County, Utah; that she is the mother of David Simon, whose application for termination of sentence or pardon came before the Board of Pardons at the special meeting held the 11th day of November, 1924; that prior to said meeting she had been advised that this application could not be brought up at this special meeting of the Board of Pardons and was not aware of the fact that the said application would come before the board at such meeting. That on account of the above mentioned facts this affiant did not appear at the meeting of the Board of Pardons held November 11th, nor present any evidence in support of the application of said David Simon for termination of sentence or pardon and did not learn that the said matter had come up before the said board until about one week after the said special meeting was held; that the husband of affiant, Charles Simon is crippled and unable to perform manual labor and therefore unable to earn enough to support the family; that there are four children of affiant at home aged three years, six years, nine years and eighteen years respectively and that the child eighteen years old is physically unable to perform manual labor and hasn't sufficient education to perform office work. In addition to the four children above mentioned who are living at home your affiant has in her care and custody a three year old child of said David Simon.

That petitioner and her husband have no property excepting an equity in a five acre tract of land in Lehi, which they are purchasing on contract of the value of not to exceed \$1500.00 and there is \$900.00 still left unpaid upon the contract price; that the family are unable to make a living and make any payments on the said contract price; that said David Simon is in good physical condition, able bodied and able to perform manual labor and that with his assistance affiant and the family of affiant and the child of said David Simon would be sufficiently taken care of and enabled to make payments as the same fell due on the contract to purchase said tract of land.

WHEREFORE petitioner prays that a rehearing be had on the application of the said David Simon as above designated at the next meeting of the Board of Pardons and that notification of the hearing on said application be mailed to affiant at Lehi, Utah, Box 114 and that due notice be given as required by law.
