To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Weber County Jail  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of having liquor in my possession

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of November  
A. D. 1923, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in the City Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable D.R. Roberts presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 180 days in jail

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Weber County Jail.

Fourth-- Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Mrs. Julia Hansen  
I was convicted under the name of Mary Hansen

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None other than myself

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
