Application of Harry Bernstein #4187

In the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Voluntary Manslaughter

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of January, A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable G. Iverson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable W. R. Hutchinson, Jr. prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Harry Bernstein

I was convicted under the name of Harry Bernstien

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
