and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephraim Hanson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve from One to Ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary

Fourth-- Honorable Ed. Rodgers prosecuted the case.
