First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary and larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the twenty third day of June
A. D. 1919, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Iverson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Alex Cowan
I was convicted under the name of Alex Cowan

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except X
