Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 24 day of March  
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City, Utah. County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. R. Iverson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term  
Five to Life  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Charles Marra.  
I was convicted under the name of Charles Marra
