County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Iverson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An Indeterminate Term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers. prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Charles Marra.

I was convicted under the name of Charles Marra.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
