and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 24 day of March
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City Utah. County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. A. Swinson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term
Five to Life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Charles Marra.
I was convicted under the name of Charles Marra

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Walter Mitchel

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None
