A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City, Utah, County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in 3<sup>rd</sup> District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Iverson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison of  
Salt Lake City, Utah

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.
