and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of December
A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to and indeterminate Sentence in the Utah
Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison, and was paroled
at the May, 1922, meeting of the Board of Pardons

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Art Frank
I was convicted under the name of Art Frank

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None
