Silver, at the time and place aforesaid, did wilfully, unlawfully and feloniously steal, take and carry away from the possession of David Spitz, against the will of the said David Spitz, personal property as follows, to-wit: One Marmon Car, Serial #7200615 Model 1921, of the value of thirty-five hundred Dollars (\$3500.00, lawful money of the U. S. of America, the said personal property being then and there the property of and within the possession of the said David Spitz.
