Gentlemen;-

In re: A. O. Frank, serving sentence for Grand Larceny.

My attention has just been called to the affidavit of Judge Henry C. Lund, who sat as a committing magistrate at the preliminary hearing in the case of the State of Utah vs. A. O. Frank with reference to the alleged stealing of Max Rosenblum's automobile in 1919, and which alleged offense had considerable to do with my recommendation of ~~xxx~~ three years as the term to be served under his recent conviction, instead of adopting the recommendation of the District Attorney that his sentence be one year.

It seems that the alleged facts set forth in the letter from the Police Department are in dispute. Judge Lund heard the evidence in that case and ought to be in a better position than any one else to pass upon the facts.

I take pleasure in forwarding this additional information for your consideration, and I am free to inform you that had I had this information at the time I would have made my recommendation one year as the term for which Mr. Frank should serve.
