Application of Thomas R. Robinson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Statutory Offense

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Sixth day of October  
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in the Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. M. McCrea presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term  
of from one to ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Thomas Ray Robinson  
I was convicted under the name of Thomas Ray Robinson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Present One
