and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in States Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Statutory offense

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Sixth day of Oct.
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. C. McCre presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to From One (1) to Ten (10)
years in the State Penitentiary
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Same.

Fourth-- Honorable E. C. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Thomas Ray Robinson
I was convicted under the name of Thomas Ray Robinson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense ~~except~~ nor have I
ever been under suspicion at any
