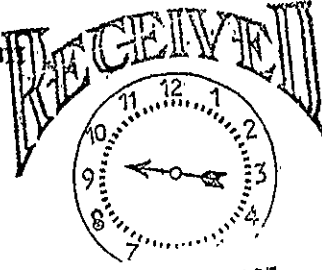

Mr. Gribble has been known to me for about four years, and up to the time of his trouble over a year ago, was esteemed by a vast number of residents of Ogden and Salt Lake. Having served over a year of the sentence, which was for a term of from one to ten years, I believe he has suffered, and possibly learned his lesson well that it does not pay to take property belonging to another — and the ends of justice subserved sufficiently, to give him a chance as a citizen again.
