County and State aforesaid, Honorable H. Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 1 to 2 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fifth-- My true name in full is Mr. Hansen

I was convicted under the name of Mr. Hansen

and hope the Honorable Board will
