Application of Ernest Dickerson, 4434

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd day of August
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Richey presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminet Term
of from one to ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable A. E. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Ernest Dickerson

I was convicted under the name of Ernest Dickerson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
