First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Indecent Assault.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of Dec.
A. D. 1923, at Ogden City, County of Weber,
and State of Utah, in Second Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James M. Kimball, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to a term not to exceed
Five Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Leon Cherry.
I was convicted under the name of William Leon Cherry.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none.
