Dear Madam:

I acknowledge receipt of your favor of the 5th instant relative to your son who is confined in the Utah State Prison.

I find, in looking up his record, that he was denied parole at the last meeting held in December, which would automatically eliminate him from appearing before the Board on a similar application at the meeting held this month. He has but one alternative and that is to submit an application for rehearing, which must be substantiated by an affidavit setting forth facts which would warrant a reconsideration of his case. This affidavit must be sworn to before a Notary Public, and there must be sufficient reason given which would permit the Board to rehear his application and to act on the same.

His application and affidavit must be submitted within the next few days or it will be too late.
