I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Indecent Assault

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of December A. D. 1923, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. N. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Jos. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Wm. L. Cherry
I was convicted under the name of Wm L. Cherry

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except several misdemeanors
