under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2d Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9 day of August
A. D. 1930, at Coeville Utah County of Summit
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable O. W. Mc Carver presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence of
1 to 20 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Gort prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of William Bernard Baxter
