Application of William Baxter

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 18 day of Sept. A. D. 1922, at Coalville County of Summit and State of Utah, in 3 Dist. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge A. R. Barnes presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Wilson McCarthy prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Baxter I was convicted under the name of William Baxter

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Marcell A. Hall, terminated Mar. 1923. James Anderson terminated June, 23.
