to receive hospitalization from the Veterans Bureau.
and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2d Degree Burglary.

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 9 day of August
A. D. 1930, at Coalville, Utah County of Summit
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable O. W. Mc Carls presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence of
1 to 20 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth--Honorable Ray Van Cotte prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is William Bernard
I was convicted under the name of William Bernard Baxter.

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except as shown
on record.
