I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 18 day of September
A. D. 1922, at Coleville County of Summit
and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. R. Barnes presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An indeterminate Term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison, Salt Lake City,
Utah

Fourth-- Honorable J. E. Johnson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Baxter

I was convicted under the name of William Baxter

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
