First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd degree burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 11 day of May
A. D. 1923, at Moab County of Grand
and State of Utah, in the 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Dilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable J. C. Corbin prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Fred Prentice

I was convicted under the name of Fred Prentice

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Joe Conley and George Borden

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the charge that
I am here on now.
