Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of May A. D. 1923, at Moab County of Grand and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Woolley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable J. Corbin prosecuted the case.
