I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County Jail
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of involuntary manslaughter

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of October
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable William M. McCrea presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve eight months

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail

Fourth-- Honorable R. H. Hutchinson, Jr. prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Alma H. Blackburn
