Application of Edward Cottrell

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Manslaughter

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of November
A. D. 1924, at Price County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in 5th Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Dillworth Wooley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to ten years recommended
With two year and six month
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Geo. J. Constantine prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Edward Cottrell
I was convicted under the name of Edward Cottrell

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: James Warner

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None
