Application of EDWARD COTTRELL,

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am ~~serving a term of imprisonment~~ now on parole, having been under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Voluntary Manslaughter.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of November, A. D. 1924, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to not less than one nor more than ten years in the State Prison of Utah, in Salt Lake County, Utah, and thereafter was imprisoned in the said State Prison of Utah, at Salt Lake City, Utah, and served about eight or nine months, and was paroled in August, 1925, to Leroy Palmer of Provo, Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable Leroy Young, assisted by G. J. Constantine prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Edward Cottrell

I was convicted under the name of Edward Cottrell

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
