Application of Edward Cottrell

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the state prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of voluntary manslaughter

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of November  
A. D. 1927, at Price County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one nor more than ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State prison

Fourth-- Honorable George J. Constantine prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Edward Cottrell  
I was convicted under the name of Edward Cottrell

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: James Warner

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none except above
