Application of Joe Baktashi

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 1st. Degree Murder

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the ~~6th~~ 11 day of May
A. D. 1914, at Provo County of Utah
and State of Utah, in Fourth district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. B. Morgan presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Life imprisonment
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable James McDowell prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Joe Baktashi
I was convicted under the name of Joe Baktashi

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same
offense are as follows: Abdul Alli

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this.
