Application of Joe Bakdash

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 1st Degree.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of May A. D. 1914, at Provo County of Utah, and State of Utah, in 4th District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Morgan presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Life Imprisonment and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable James H. McQuaid prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joe Bakdash. I was convicted under the name of Joe Bakdash.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Abdul Alli.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None
