Application of LORENZO HADLEY

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of carnal knowledge, now under parole.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the second day of April
A. D. 1924, at Ogden City, County of Weber
and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term in Utah State prison,
not to exceed five years,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison,

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Lorenzo Hadley
I was convicted under the name of Lorenzo Hadley

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Gladys Tracy

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
