I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December  
A. D. 1923, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second Jud District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James M. Kimbrell presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to not to exceed five (5) years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Cecil Emerson Bates  
I was convicted under the name of Cecil Emerson Bates
