I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole or Commutation  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 2nd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of June  
A. D. 1919, at San Manti County of San Pete  
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christenson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to a LIFE sentence  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Knox Patterson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Ramon Archuletta
