

Gentlemen:

In the above entitled matter the defendant was convicted of Grand Larceny by his plea of guilty and this is another case where the court has very little information in addition to that contained in the information. The defendant is a transient and I have learned nothing of his past record. He was employed at Lucine to bring in by road a part of a construction outfit. Along the road he met a loose horse and he caught the animal and brought it along with him for some distance when he traded it off for a mule and sold the mule after reaching Ogden.

The animals taken were of small value and my recommendation is that the sentence be terminated at the expiration of the minimum sentence of one year. I therefore recommend that the petition set for June 20th be granted.
