Application of Frank Nestell

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah, State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of August  
A. D. 1923, at Price County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Hammond presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence of from 90 days to  
Ten Years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah; State Prison at Salt Lake City, Utah
